

Watercolours Materials list

Palette - with wells for colours and mixing areas. (You can use a white dinner plate.)

Large jar/water container

Pencils - B or HB

Sharpener or knife

Pencil rubber or kneadable eraser

Tissues

* **Paper** - must be watercolour paper - 300gm min weight.

Cold press- Archers, Saunders, Bockinford, A3 pad.

* **Brushes**

1) large round brush No. 10 or 12 with good paint and water holding capacity. The best are very expensive sable, so for beginners at Eckersleys Crows Nest they have Roymac (synthetic) brushes - orange - resembles sable.

2) Round brushes no. 10 and no. 6 (tablon).

3) Cheap oil brush (bristle) for scrubbing out.

* **Paints** - Winsor and Newton or (student quality) Cotman.
